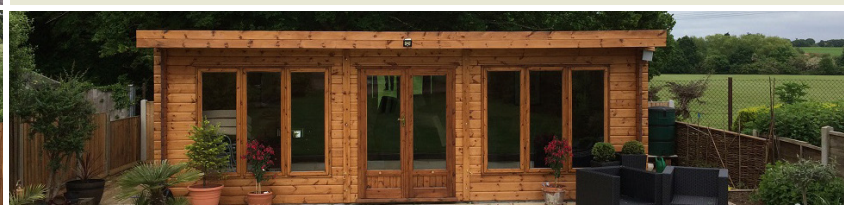

Providing a correct base for a Log Cabin

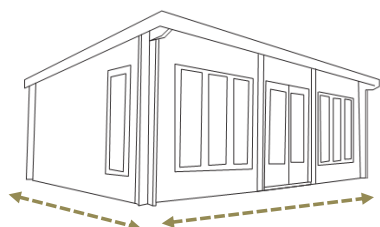
Our timber buildings ideally need a concrete base due to the weight of timber construction. The base should be solid and flat; if in doubt, please consult a structural engineer. The base size ideally should be 3"(75mm) larger for 44 mm cabins and 5"(125mm) larger for 68 mm cabins than the internal ordered size (on this leaflet). N.B. All our log cabins are sold as agricultural or portable buildings and should not be used as dwellings. If located in exposed locations, customers should consider using ground anchors or bonds to secure their building.

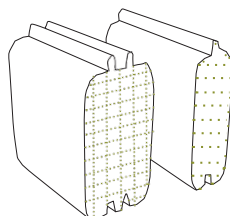
6 easy steps to your bespoke Log Cabin



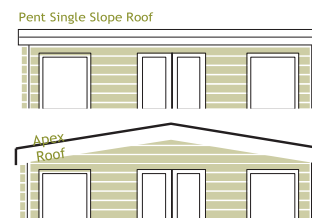
1. Decide on your internal floorspace requirements, remember to keep an additional 500mm space spare around the building for servicing purposes.



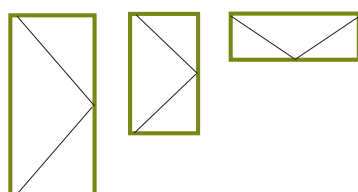
2. Choose from 68mm or 44mm thickness timber logs for the cabin. Both use our unique four-way notching system with pressure treated floor bearers.



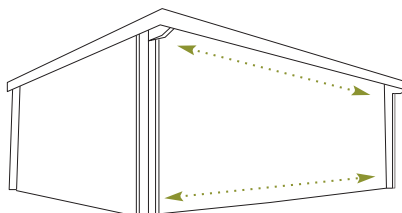
3. Roofing format can be either Pent or Apex, you decide which type is best for your building and your needs, see the page opposite for a quick guide.



4. Choose your preference of door and window types: contemporary type (double glazed) in either 1/2 length or 3/4 or high level vent window; glazed or solid doors.



5. Select where the openings for the windows and doors are located to suit your garden, morning or evening sun position or cabin location.



6. Lastly decide on any extras or upgrades you would like; partition walls, verandas, porches, or even extra insulation and then we build to your specification.
